

The GCSE has TWO Components:

Component 01: Portfolio -

Learners produce a portfolio of practical work showing their personal response to a centre or learner-set starting point.

Component 02: Externally Set Task -

The paper is issued on 2 January each year and provides five themes, each with a range of written and visual starting points. A response should be based on one of these options.

Assessment Objectives:

AO1 Develop ideas through investigations, demonstrating critical understanding of sources.

AO2 Refine work by exploring ideas, selecting and experimenting with appropriate media, materials, techniques and processes.

AO3 Record ideas, observations and insights relevant to intentions as work progresses.

AO4 Present a personal and meaningful response that realises intentions and demonstrates understanding of visual language.
