This is a four-year term of office, commencing from the date of appointment.

Foundation Governors are personally appointed by **His Grace**, the **Most Reverend Bernard Longley**, Archbishop of Birmingham, to represent both his interests and those of the wider Catholic community in diocesan schools.

Governors work collaboratively as a team, closely supporting the headteacher and school staff. Foundation Governors share the responsibilities of all governors, which include:

- Ensuring clarity of vision, ethos, and strategic direction
- Holding the headteacher to account for the educational performance of the school and its pupils, as well as the performance management of staff
- Acting as a "critical friend" by offering both support and constructive challenge to school leadership
- Supporting the overall work and mission of the school

In addition, Foundation Governors have a special responsibility to:

- Preserve and promote the Catholic character of the school
- Ensure that Religious Education is delivered in accordance with the Bishop's policies for the Diocese
