you should....

## After each lesson

- Re-read your material from the lesson and look up any vocabulary you do not understand
- Prepare a list of questions to ask your teacher
- Evaluate your verb knowledge and practice different tenses each week

## Every week

- Add to your list of facts based in the French speaking world for each topic
- Log into Kerboodle and complete a reading or listening exercises not used in class
- Spend 30 minutes reading / watching the news from a Francophone country

## Every term

- Collate your notes on the book / film and make a mind-map the key themes
- Evaluate your grammar knowledge against the specification. Complete exercises on Seneca or online to improve weaknesses
