Behaviour and Positive Recognition Policy

Lateness/U Codes/Supporting attendance: Pupils who arrive late to school after 8.45am will be required to serve a same day detention.

Supporting pupils to accept the consequences of their actions
Pupils who arrive late to school will be asked to hand in their mobile phone at reception, or another personal item, until the end of the school day. This measure is intended to encourage pupils to attend their detention and take responsibility for the consequences of their choices.

Pupils who are issued with a detention will also be required to hand in their mobile phone, or another item of similar value, at reception.

Pupils who frequently as seen using their phone and therefore breaking the 'turned off and in your bag' rule, will be required to hand their phone in at the gate or at reception.

Phones will be stored in a locked safe in a secure area until the end of the school day. Items can be collected once the detention has been completed.

The school will take reasonable care when storing items. However, the school cannot accept responsibility for items that pupils fail to collect.
