Following a further review of the weather forecast and the severe warning issued today, we would like to inform you that students **WILL** be permitted to wear their **full PE kit** to school from **Monday 22 June 2026**.

This decision has been made to help students remain comfortable during the anticipated warm weather conditions. This arrangement will be **reviewed daily** in line with the latest weather forecasts, and any changes will be communicated promptly.

Students must wear the full school PE kit **ONLY**. Please note that alternative clothing items, including branded sportswear, leggings of any colour, hoodies, tracksuit bottoms, cycling shorts, or other non-uniform items, are **not allowed**.



Expectations and Consequences

To ensure consistency and maintain our high standards of uniform, any student who attends school wearing an item that is not part of the approved PE kit will be required to comply with the following procedures:

- Parents/carers will be contacted and asked to bring the correct item(s) into school.
- Students will be provided with appropriate school-issued clothing to change into where necessary.
- We expect all students to cooperate fully with staff and change into the correct kit if required.

Should a student refuse to change into the correct PE kit or uniform item, they will be placed in isolation and may be subject to further sanctions in line with the school's behaviour policy.

Students are required to wear appropriate footwear as they would for PE, cros are **NOT** allowed.

Rules regarding jewellery remain the same, students are permitted to wear **one** pair of small studs in the ear lobe only, no other jewellery is allowed.
