Dear Parents and Carers,

Following a further review of the weather forecast, we would like to inform you that students **WILL** be permitted to wear their **full PE kit** to school from **Wednesday 8th July 2026** for the rest of the week.

This decision has been made to help students remain comfortable during the anticipated warm weather conditions. This arrangement will be **reviewed** in line with the latest weather forecasts, and any changes for next week will be communicated promptly.

Students must wear the full school PE kit **ONLY**. Please note that alternative clothing items, including branded sportswear, leggings of any colour, hoodies, tracksuit bottoms, cycling shorts, or other non-uniform items, are **not allowed**. For students not comfortable in PE kit, they may wear uniform without a blazer or tie.



Expectations and Consequences

To ensure consistency and maintain our high standards of uniform, action to be taken for any student who attends school wearing an item that is not part of the approved PE kit is detailed here-

- Parents/carers will be contacted and asked to bring the correct item(s) into school.
- Students will be provided with appropriate school-issued clothing to change into where necessary.
- We expect all students to cooperate fully with staff and change into the correct kit if required.

Should a student refuse to change into the correct PE kit or uniform item, they will be placed in isolation and may be subject to further sanctions in line with the school's behaviour policy.

Students are required to wear appropriate footwear as they would for PE, crocs are **NOT** allowed.

Rules regarding jewellery remain the same, students are permitted to wear **one** pair of small studs in the ear lobe only, no other jewellery is allowed.
